- Up to 4 archers per boss, shooting in two details. Ends will consist of 6 arrows in 4 minutes
- Assembly 10.15am, Sighters 10.30am.
- Entry Fee £8 Seniors and juniors free entry

- Judges – Judge in charge Chris Platon Norman McColl
- Awards for Recurve, Compound, Longbow & Barebow depending on entries.
- Refreshments will be available on the day. Bacon/ Sausage butties, crisps, choc & cake.
- Results will be available on the LAA website or by email if you add your address to the form.
- Disabled archers are asked to indicate their requirements on the entry form or contact the tournament organiser.
- Raffle will be held at the end of the shoot before awards ceremony.
