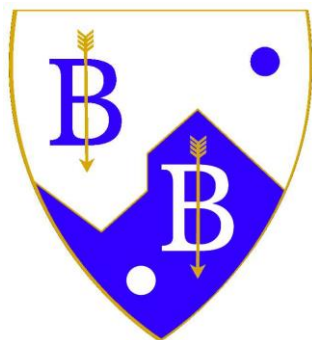

Blackpool Bowmen Junior Open Metrics 2018 – Information Sheet

1. The Tournament is open to all archers aged under 18 on the day of the competition. An archer may compete in a round for an older group but will only be eligible for a prize in the round shot.
2. The entry fee is £10.00. Please return entries form(s) with the appropriate fee to the Tournament Organiser at the address given, making cheques payable to “Blackpool Bowmen”.
3. Subject to availability entries may be accepted after the closing date of 1st April 2018. The entry fee for entries after the closing date is £12.00.
4. No substitutions accepted and no refunds will be made.
5. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. Please contact the Tournament Organiser if you require acknowledgement of receipt. Incomplete or unfunded applications will not be accepted.
6. The target list and results will be emailed to all entrants and published on the LAA website. Please enclose an SAE marked “Target List” and/or “Results” if you would like a paper copy posted.
7. Neither Blackpool Bowmen nor the Tournament Organiser is able to accept responsibility for the care of children. All competitors must be accompanied by a responsible adult during the tournament.
8. Competitors must be members of Archery GB, and membership cards must be shown on registration.
IMPORTANT: Entrants may participate only after proof of Archery GB membership has been provided.
9. In line with the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy, anyone wishing to take photographs or video at the shoot must register with the Tournament Organiser prior to doing so.
10. As this is a Record Status tournament, archers will be liable for drug testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply; a refusal will be treated as a positive result.
11. Blackpool Bowmen will not be responsible for damage to equipment.
12. The Tournament venue is the shooting ground of Blackpool Bowmen - Fleetwood Road, Blackpool FY5 3AJ. Please see our website at www.blackpoolbowmen.co.uk
