## Eccles Double WA 720 70m & WA 720 60m World Record Status Tournament

Tournament Organiser: Mark Leach

- Sunday 20th May 2018
- World Record Status (confirmed) Double FITA 70m (WA 720 70m): 6 dozen at 70 metres, 122cm face, 10 zone scoring, faces to be marked.
- World Record Status (confirmed) Double FITA 60m (WA 720 60m): 6 dozen at 60 metres, 122cm face, 10 zone scoring, faces to be marked.
- Two sessions: 9:30am and 2:00pm. Equipment check will start at 9:00am, assembly at 9:30, two ends of practice and then straight into the competition. Afternoon, 1:45 equip. check, 2:00pm assembly.
- Lord Paramount: Roger Burgess, LAA President.
- Judges: Phil Morris (J-in-C), Lorraine Morris plus other(s) (TBC).
- Shooting will be under Archery GB/GNAS rules. All entrants must be members of Archery GB or a World Archery affiliated organisation. Dress regulations must be conformed to.
- There will be 'double scoring'. WA timing (10 sec & 4 min) under control of a Regional Judge. Shooting will be controlled by lights.
- Four archers per boss, two detail shooting: mixed lady/gent & mixed recurve/comp/LB/BB.
- The competitors at this record status shoot will be liable for drug testing and those approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors must have a parent or guardian sign the entry form to signify consent for their child being tested if approached.
- In line with Archery GB Child Protection Policy, anyone wishing to take photographs or video at the competition must register with the organiser.
- Medals L/G x RC/Comp/LB/BB & mixed team-of-three shooting 70m will be awarded at the end of the shoot, depending upon entries. The team-of-three & 60m junior awards will be calculated against the equivalent bowman handicap. There will be no awards for seniors shooting 60m. EAC members will not be eligible for awards.
- Archers shooting both sessions will only be eligible for a medal and/or team award for their first score (like an
  indoor shoot). However, there will be a most improved award calculated over the two rounds... and the famous
  Eccles Wooden Spoon for the most deteriorated archer over the two rounds.
- Prepayment by cheque is essential to confirm a place. Please make these made payable to Eccles Archery


