- Practice bosses will be available on Friday from 3p.m.
- Dogs are allowed on the Shooting Ground provided they are kept under strict control and on a lead. (Must be exercised off the Shooting Ground and caravan site.)
- Camping & Caravans. Stay Friday & Saturday nights with your tent or caravan. £4.00 per van or tent per night including 2 people. Additional people £1.00 each per night. The ground must be vacated by 7p.m. on Sunday evening. Space is limited - so please book early to avoid disappointment.
- The use of portable gas appliances or BBQ's will not be permitted on the shooting field in the interest of archers' safety.

Timed ends of 6 arrows in  
4 minutes will apply.

**Please Note:**

Traditional straw bosses and three legged target stands will be used at the shoot. Please consider this if you are using a high powered bow and arrows that you think may be affected by such bosses and stands.

**PLEASE NOTE** - When you enter our competition the information you give us will be collected and used by the Club in relation to running this and future shoots. Certain information will also be used in a scoring system and will be shared with other competitors on target lists and result sheets and may be published, eg: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Age category, Club, County, Region, Round (unless defined by age), Disability and marital status where relevant to an award or category. Contact details will be kept in relation to the return of trophies and to comply with GNAS/AGB's rules regarding Record & Rose Status tournaments and to notify archers of future competitions held by the Club.

## NEW CENTURY BOWMEN OPEN YORK/HEREFORD/BRISTOLS I-V (The Double Round)

### AWARDS

#### THE JAY-DEE TROPHY

for the highest recurve score on either the Double York or the Double Hereford Round. The winner of this trophy is not eligible as the First Lady, First Gentleman or First Junior.

**TROPHIES** for 1st Lady, 1st Gent, 1st Junior Lady & 1st Junior Gent in Recurve, Compound & Longbow Classes.

**JACK & JILL TROPHIES** for Recurve & Compound (For husbands and wives only).

#### NEW CENTURY TWISTED ARROW.

A team of 3 Recurve archers from one club all shooting senior rounds, one of which must be a lady or a junior shooting the round of their gender.

#### BEST GOLDS

Ladies, Gents & Junior Classes.

We are happy to allow any archer to shoot the round of their choice and would ask you to state on the entry form which round you wish to shoot.

Awards however, will be given on the basis of the above rounds and age groups.

**If the tournament is abandoned, trophies / medals shall be awarded up to and including the last complete end shot.**

**RECORD STATUS SHOOTS** will be liable for Drug Testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If competitors refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

**PHOTOGRAPHY.** In order to comply with the GNAS/AGB Protection of Children & Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival.

**DISCIPLINE.** The Director of Judges is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times. His/her decision in all matters is final and must be obeyed. The Tournament Organiser has the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour.

**G.N.A.S./Archery GB Rules of Shooting (including dress rules) will apply.**
